Call to Order and Introductions:

 Chair Jacob Torgerson called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM in person at Lewis and Clark Library and via Zoom. Legislative Redistricting: Jacob Torgerson

- The Republican maps exhibit extreme partisan gerrymandering. Although Dems received 57% of the
 vote in the elections analyzed, Republicans drew districts that would win them 72% of the seats. This
 would guarantee a solid Republican legislative majority FOR THE NEXT TEN YEARS. Helena
 needs to maintain FIVE competitive House seats.
- R's eliminated a majority-minority (Native) Senate district, contrary the VRA.
- The Central Zone Zoom hearing (includes Helena) is September 9. Jacob Hopkins at the MDP is lead on analysis and talking points. (jacob@montanademocrats.org)

2022 Montana Democratic Platform Convention

KEEPING RURAL HOSPITALS OPEN


Medicaid Expansion has helped ensure that not a single rural hospital in Montana has closed, while cutting average healthcare costs for rural residents by over 40%!




